### ALL DRIVERS:

When a fuel stop requests a trailer number in order to fuel, and the pump will not accept the number of the dry trailer, (for example- #5035), **USE #9999**. In the past you may have been informed to make up a number or use a reefer number or #1111. Please note this change:

**As of 4-1-09 use #9999.** By using this number anytime the correct dry van number does not work, there will be no confusion and we can keep track of where there may be issues with certain fueling stations-ex: Pilot in Highland, Indiana.
